Youngest social influencer – 11 years old brought joy to so many people... went out to pick flowers in the tiny garden she had cultivated. Killed by a drone



Adam al-Najjar (11) is the only surviving child of Doctors Hamdi and Alaa al-Najjar, his nine siblings having been bombed. Dr Hamdi al-Najjar has died of his injuries. Italy has offered to treat Adam who is critically injured, but Israelis not budging. Please pray for him and his mother, who continues to work.

5 year old [Ward Khalil](#) escaped the fire in which her mother and siblings died and found her uncle.

As far as I can tell, around 300 people have been killed this week, many at the aid distribution site.

Aid distribution. On the Today programme this morning (3/6/25), an Israeli spokesman claimed that Hamas is responsible for the deaths at the aid distribution sites. The individuals were moving towards forces in a way that "posed a threat to them", the [military said](#). [Israel has killed at least 102 Palestinians](#) and wounded nearly 500 others at so-called aid delivery points since the US-backed Gaza Aid Foundation began operating. 32 people were shot over the weekend, 15 people on Monday, and so far, today, 27 fatalities.

The Gaza Aid Foundation, which manages the aid distribution, was set up with donations from a mystery funder – who turns out to be... [Mossad and the Israeli government](#). The article tells us that the strategy replicates the [Nazi programme of deliberate starvation](#) of Jewish people in the ghettos.
